Garbage and Recycling

The MYCT has put in place a new arrangement for waste disposal and recyclable material collection.

With our contractors Veolia we have organised a new larger and more presentable rubbish waste collection bin adjacent to the Bosun's shed.

Please note that under no circumstances can oil, fuel or flammable liquids go into any of the rubbish collection bins. No oil is to be left in containers around the bins.

With the greater emphasis on recycling we have installed extra collection points with **recycle material only** bins being placed adjacent to each Marina arm.

A large **recycle material only** bin has been placed next to the big rubbish bin near the Bosun's shed. This is for your convenience to allow rubbish and recycle material disposal at the one location.

The recycle bins are for waste paper, plastics, cans and glass. All recyclable materials should be placed loosely in the bins and not in comingled in bags or other containers.

We are continually trying to keep the Clubhouse and surrounds clean and tidy for your enjoyment so please assist us to keep your Club presentable at all times.
